


How does Financial Aid work?

Grants: Federal Pell Grant and state grant programs

Direct Subsidized Loan : No interest accrues while in school, no credit check needed, low interest rate, flexible repayment options

Direct Unsubsidized Loan: Interest does accrue while in school, no credit check needed, low interest rate, flexible repayment options

Plus Loan : A federal loan option for parents of dependent students, low fixed interest rates, credit based

Student Contribution: You can make payments with savings, assistance from family members, Employer reimbursement or agency

Institutional Loans: No credit check needed, loan repayment begins while in school, affordable repayment options

Scholarships: Institutional scholarships and outside scholarships

Campus Based Funding : Federal Supplemental Opportunity Grant and Federal Work Study Program
